SPECIAL VOTERS MEETING

The Church Council has set the date for a special voters meeting. The date and time: **Sunday, June 4, at 9:15 a.m.** The purpose of the meeting will be three-fold: 1) to present the 2017-2018 proposed budget for approval; 2) to request permission from the voters to borrow \$15,000 from the bank if our offerings fall short during the summer months; the voters set a limit of 'internal borrowing' up to \$60,000.00 and that limit has nearly been reached; as a result we will need to go to the bank for a bank loan if offerings fall short; and 3) to seek authorization to call a pastor to replace Pastor Schafer.

REMEDIAL TEACHER NEEDED
