DECISIONS FROM THE SPECIAL VOTERS MEETING

The following decisions were made at the special voters meeting held last Sunday, June 4:

- 1- The 2017-2018 budget was approved; it represents an increase of 2.7% over last year's budget
- 2- Approval was given to borrow \$15,000 from the bank if offerings fall short during the summer months
- 3- The decision was made to call a pastor to replace Pastor Schafer who accepted a Call to serve a congregation in Jacksonville, FL
- 4- Approval was given to provide assistance from retired pastors or someone from FVL to preach/conduct services 2 weekends per month until Pastor Schafer's replacement is in place
