The following procedures have been set in place:

- 1- A sign-up sheet will be placed in the back of church. If you are interested in filling out a survey, you are asked to **sign your name AND indicate your e-mail address**. If you do not have an e-mail address, you are asked to call the church office (867-2200) and arrangements will be made for you to receive a survey. (cut-off date: June 25)
- 2- Those filling out a survey must be communicant members of St. Peter.
- 3- There is to be only one form per household; opinions can be shared on the same form.
- 4- **The surveys are to be returned to the office or to the church and placed in the designated box at the back of the church NO LATER THAN Sunday, July 2.**
