ST. PETER SCHOOL 2023-2024

We are already planning for next school year. The calling process has begun for two additional teachers. This year we experienced a 9% increase in enrollment over last year's numbers. In grades 3K-4th, St Peter currently has 84 students attending school. A couple of classrooms are either at or very near capacity. **Current families who already have children attending St. Peter, as well as members of St. Peter & Immanuel Churches who do not currently send their children, are strongly encouraged to enroll their children for the '23-'24 school year between January 16, 2023 and March 24, 2023.** After March 24, you can still enroll your child, but Open Enrollment will begin for those outside of our church and school families. On March 25, classes will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis for members and nonmembers alike.

If you plan on sending your child to St. Peter next year, **it is important to get them enrolled now.** Returning a completed enrollment form (available from the school office) and non-refundable \$50.00 per family registration fee to the school office prior to March 25th holds your child(ren)'s spot for next year.

MURALS

At the request of the Trustees and with the direction of the Church Council, the Sanctuary Committee was asked to explore the restoration of the murals in the front of the sanctuary. The murals have been deteriorating for some time. With the congregational approval of the installation of screens last year, the Sanctuary Committee was asked to find a solution that incorporated both of these projects. The results of that research was reflected in two options that were shared with the congregation over the last few weeks.

At the January quarterly congregational meeting, it was decided to restore the murals and reposition them above the installation of the screens. The costs of removing, restoring and reestablishing the murals higher on the wall along with the restoration of the wall is approximately \$60,000. Individual members have already made contributions for this purpose. If you are interested in helping to restore these murals and maintain the traditional look of our sanctuary, please make contribution specifically to the Mural Fund.
