	Worship Ministry
Greeter	Greet members and visitors with a friendly smile and greeting to make everyone feel welcome at St. Peter. Sign-up are available at the back of church.
Usher	Welcome and assist members and guests. Collect offerings at services and obtain a headcount of attendance.
Technology Assistant	Set-up, operate and monitor technology for worship services. Assist with video, audio and power point presentations as part of worship service.
Banner Committee	Help design and create banners that help us celebrate the church seasons and special occasions while beautifying our church.
Worship Committee	Works with the Pastors to identify, discuss and evaluate worship needs and opportunities for our congregation.
Communion Server	Serve communion during communion services.

Friends Assisting Christian Education (FACE)	Serves the congregation and Christian day school by providing a pool of willing volunteers to help with activities that foster family fellowship and raise funds for the needs of Christian education. Examples: Family Fun Night and Spaghetti Supper
SPL Children's Bible Hour	Teach or substitute at children's bible hour. Held Sundays from 9:15 am to 10:15 am September – May.
SPL Nursery Bible Hour	Teach or substitute at nursery bible hour. Held Sundays from 9:15 am to 10:15 am September – May.
SPL Teen Bible Hour	Teach or substitute at teen bible hour. Held Sundays from 9:15 am to 10:15 am September – May.
FVL Representative	Attend three general board meetings at FVL. Vote on proposals from the Board of Regents. Deliver inserts or other FVL material for the SPL congregation. Report on happenings (ex. Budgets, Growing in Grace) at the quarterly voter's meetings.

Choir	Everyone is welcome there are no auditions. Practice on Tuesday nights at 7:30 from September – May. Sing twice a month, one early and one late service.
Bell Choir	Practice on Tuesday nights at 6:30 from September – May. Perform twice a month at services.
Organist	Use God given talent of playing the organ to beautify our worship service.
Pianist	Use God given talent of playing the piano to beautify our worship service.
Soloist	Use God given talent of singing to beautify our worship service.
Instrumentalist	Use God given talent of playing an instrument to beautify our worship service.

Ladies Aid	Service organization that seeks to serve the congregation in many different capacities.
Lutheran Women’s Mission Society (LWMS)	Women in WELS Congregations all across the US and the world, dedicated to serving Jesus by increasing awareness of, interest in, and support of the Home and World Mission outreach of the WELS
Bible Study Leader	Working with Pastors, lead small group of women in Bible Study
Special Events	Organize donate and/or assist with events that provide women opportunities for spiritual growth such as speaker program or retreats
Advent by Candlelight	An event to help women focus on Christ during the busy holiday season. Most commonly, women gather for a brief service or program followed by food and fellowship. Outreach opportunity to the community to encourage believers. Help with planning or being a hostess.

Bible study leader	Working with Pastors, lead small group of men in Bible Study
Special Events	Organize donate and/or assist with events that provide men opportunities for spiritual growth such as speaker program or retreats

Every Day God is Epic (EDGE)	A SPL teen group that plans faith, fellowship and service opportunities

Food Pantry	The food pantry provides food to those experiencing an emergency or shortage that live within the Weyauwega-Fremont School District. Volunteers collect nonperishable food items at SPL or work at the pantry

Dartball	Play on a dirtball team that competes with other churches.
Easter Breakfast	Volunteer to help prepare, serve, advertise or donate items for the Easter Breakfast.
Special Events	Lead, assist or donate to special events that provide for Christian fellowship

Clerical (bulletins/mailing)	Assist office staff with clerical duties.
Special Event phone callers	Call our members to invite them to an upcoming event or opportunity at church or school.
Member Ministry Committee	Committed to helping all members feel welcomed and engaged by identifying ministry opportunities at SPL.
Finance Committee	Develops annual operating budget, monitors finances of school & church and recommends financial policies.
Communications Committee	Assist with the newsletter, web-site and photography.
Technology Committee	Planning and oversight of technology program for church and school.
Technology Assistant	Set-up, operate and monitor technology for event in Commons & Narthex.
Carpentry	Assist with any special construction projects at school or church.
HVAC	Assist with any project or repairs that involve the heating, ventilation, or air conditioning systems.
Plumbing	Assist with any special plumbing needs at school or church.
Electrical	Assist with any electrical projects or repairs at school or church.
Church Cleaner	Assist with cleaning sanctuary of church May – October.
Landscaping Maintenance	Help beautify the SPL campus by assisting with mowing, landscaping, planting, watering etc.
Small repair/light maintenance	Assist with small miscellaneous maintenance projects at school and church.
Snow Removal	Assist with snow-blowing or shoveling at church or school. Under the direction of the Trustees
	Elected Positions
President	Presides over the monthly council meetings, congregational voter's meetings which are held quarterly and any special meetings.
Vice President	Attend monthly council meetings and quarterly voter meetings. Assumes the duties of the president in the president's absence. Chairman of the Visiting Elders which meet the first Wednesday of each month.
Secretary	Records minute minutes at the monthly council and quarterly voter's meetings. 3-year term of office.
Treasurer	Attend monthly council meetings and finance committee meetings. Responsible for keeping accurate records of all receipts and disbursements and paying all bills approved by the Finance Committee.
Trustee	Responsible for maintaining the congregation property. Custodians in all legal matters. Attend monthly council meetings and trustee/finance meetings. Are members of the finance committee. 3-year term of office.
Deacon	Responsible for physical preparation (opening lights, etc.) of church services. Setup for communion services and assist with serving communion. Attend monthly council meetings and deacon meetings. 3-year term.
Visiting Elder	Consists of nine members who consult together concerning the spiritual state of the congregation including church attendance, communion, and discipline cases. Attend monthly visiting elder meetings
School Board	Determines policy for our Christian Day School. Aid in solving school problems and difficulties as they occur. Advocate and promote the welfare of our Christian Day School in particular, and Christian education in general – 3-year term
Head Usher	Assist the Deacon at worship services with ushering etc. at the worship services they are assigned. 3-year term.
