Fox Valley Lutheran (FVL) High School News

FVL is a member of the NEC (North Eastern Conference) and decisions were reached last week on fans at fall sports events. We want you to be aware of these protocols and are asking you to share that announcement below with members of your church/school family.

Football, Boys Soccer, And Girls Volleyball Spectators . . .

For football, boys soccer, and girls volleyball, fans will be limited to 2 spectators per student-athlete for all JV2, JV1, and Varsity events.

A sign-up link has been shared with the athletes and immediate family. Spectators are required to sign up on a pass list by noon of the day before the event. Students will not be allowed unless they are a sibling of an athlete and sitting with a parent or guardian — they are counted as one of the two allowed spectators.

- For cross country and girls golf, spectators are required to stay 15 yards away from the participants and not allowed to interact until after the event in the parking lot.
- Girls tennis is not an NEC conference sport, but spectators are expected to follow the same guidelines.)

For fans who wish to follow the Foxes online, all home events for football, varsity volleyball, and JV1 volleyball will be livestreamed, and equipment is being installed to include varsity soccer games.
