**New CDC Guidelines**

The Waupaca County Health Department has adopted the new guidelines put out by the CDC for 'close contact' quarantining. St. Peter Lutheran School has now implemented these new guidelines. The guidelines include a 7-10 day quarantine for those coming into close contact with someone having COVID-19. If your child comes into close contact with another person having COVID-19, he/she should quarantine for 10 days. To shorten this time frame, you can have your child tested for COVID-19 **starting on DAY 6 of their quarantine**. If a negative test is the result and there are no symptoms, then your child could return to school on either Day 8 or Day 9 or Day 10 of the quarantine. PLEASE SEE THE
