On campus, we continually strive to keep our student body cohorts separated from each other as much as possible. Even at monthly school devotions, classrooms have been at least six feet apart from each other. Over the past few weeks we have discussed procedures for the children's Christmas program. With a goal of being as safe as possible, not only for our students but also for families and visitors as well, the School Board has approved the following for having the students of St. Peter share the Christmas message this year. It will be done virtually via a short video. The video will be shown at various St. Peter Sunday services during the month of December. Each classroom will record their song and the recitation part that has been assigned to them. All of the parts will be compiled together and put into a video lasting about 10 minutes. The plan is to include the vocal recordings and still shots of the students. There will be no formal Children's service as has been done in the past on December 20th or 24th.
