### **Building Project**

Much work has been accomplished in creating plans for an addition to our school building. The plan calls for two phases of construction. One phase is to construct a 16,000 sq. ft. Early Childhood center. The second phase includes adding three classrooms (approximately 4,000 to 7,000 square feet) to be used by St. Peter Lutheran School grades K-8. There will be two separate occasions when the Early Childhood committees will share their formal proposal to the congregation. All are invited to attend either of the presentations. They will be held Saturday, November 5, starting at 5:30 pm with a meal and Sunday, November 13, at 11:30 am. Both informational meetings will be held at St. Peter. On Thursday, December 1, there will be a special voters' meeting at St. Peter to make a decision on whether or not to continue moving forward with the project.
