Next School Year

Planning for the next year has already begun. This is the time we receive calls from prospective parents interested in learning about our school and possibly sending their children here to hear God's Word on a daily basis. With this communication, we are attempting to begin getting an idea of student numbers for the 2021-2022 school year and give you the opportunity to secure a spot for your child(ren).

Attached you will find a commitment form that allows you to share with us your intent on sending your child(ren) next school year. Because you already have a child or children in our school, we are giving you the first opportunity to hold a spot for them. To secure a spot, complete the form and return it along with a nonrefundable \$50.00 per family deposit to the school. The deposit will be applied to next year's tuition costs. **Please complete the attached commitment form and return it right away even if you are not planning to send your child or are unsure at this time. If you do not have a printer, you can contact the school office and ask that a form be mailed to you or sent home with your child.** Starting February 22nd, an Open Enrollment period will begin for all prospective parents seeking to enroll their children at St. Peters.
