Snow day information for Waupaca Bus Riders: Please remember some details for snow days:

If Waupaca School District does not have school and St. Peter (Weyauwega School District) does it is the parent's responsibility to transport their children to school or call and let us know they will be absent.

If Waupaca School District has an early release due to bad weather they will send a transfer bus at the time of **their dismissal**. Example: Waupaca gets released at 1pm due to weather but St. Peter is not having an early dismissal your child would either go home on the Waupaca Bus at 1pm or a parent needs to pick their child up at 3:10pm. A Parent should call the school to let us know what to do with their child.

If Weyauwega School District/St. Peter Lutheran School has an early dismissal and Waupaca School District does not, it is the parent's responsibility to pick their child up at the time of St. Peter Lutheran School's dismissal.
