St. Peter Worship Series - Discipleship: Following Jesus

Throughout September and October, the worship focus will be on Christian discipleship with stories from Matthew and teachings from Hebrews. This weekend's theme (Sep. 12-13) is "Carry Heavy Crosses". All are invited to worship with us at St. Peter Lutheran Church.

Church Entry

We will begin using the Narthex (west parking lot) for worship services entry and exit starting this weekend. **NOTE – it is for entry/exit ONLY.** There will be no seating permitted in the Narthex or library, and no indoor socializing before or after the services. The restroom in the hallway toward the school will be available.

Church Attendance

We will be taking church attendance this year as usual. As a service to you, we provide avenues for you to be connected with the gospel through Word and Sacrament. Offering regular weekend worship services is one way that we accomplish that. We take attendance to be able to help encourage you in your worship life. St. Peter has gone back to offering three services each weekend at 4 pm Saturdays and 8 am & 10:30 am Sundays. If you are uncomfortable with attending in-person, you can listen to the 7:00 am Sunday broadcast on the radio at WDUX FM 92.7. [YES, the radio broadcast has moved to that early time slot due to scheduling conflicts with the station.] You could also watch via live-streaming at 10:30 am on our Facebook page. When church attendance is taken in school, either in-person worship, listening on the radio, live-streaming, or another Christian service will be accepted for attendance.
