Last night (2/28/24) the voters of St. Peter Lutheran Congregation had several items of business pertaining directly to the school. 1) Mrs. Deanna Robbins was extended a permanent call to be our special education teacher as she has completed her synodical certification. 2) Mrs. Cassandra Rupno was extended another one-year provisional call to be our teacher in grades 7-8 as she continues to work on her synodical certification. 3) The congregation adopted the name "St. Peter Stepping Stones Early Learning Center" for the new center that begins construction next week. 4) It was approved to request a call list from the synod to call a director for "Stepping Stones Early Learning Center". That call meeting is scheduled for Sunday, March 17 at 11:30 am. 5) Tuition prices were approved for next school year. Tuition charges will be \$1140.00 for members and \$1862.00 for nonmembers.
