Mr. Miller's Classes

Today's 8th grade Math lesson on rational/irrational numbers went well. I'm looking forward to checking their assignment. Grades 5-6 will have to say the Old Testament books of the Bible to you parents tonight. (9.7.23) Parents you do not have to give them a grade yet. Kindergarten News: -We are diving into our work this week with full classes and practicing our letters and work. This week we met Cass, our first superkid, She will be teaching us about the letter C and what it sounds like when it makes it's hard sound. We may have a secret to remind us when the soft sound is used too! We are working on shapes in math and what is a flat(2D) and solid(3D) shape.
